  3. Bus/Van transportation via district or school buses, or via private bus companies;
  4. Grant cannot pay for private automobile costs or food;

All K-12 schools or programs that are located in the San Luis Valley Region. A final award decision will be based on completeness of the application, curriculum connection, and available funds.
